### Meeting Rooms & Venues:

Facilities accommodate various size (10 - 300) groups for programs, meetings, sleeping and dining all year long.

**Main Education Building** Indoor classrooms, tables, chairs, chalkboards, equipped to run slides, power point presentations, wi-fi internet access, DVDs & CDs.

**The Nature Lodge** features a classroom for activities and indoor events as well as private, out of the way space for meetings and workshops.

### Food Service:

The Dining Hall serves as the main food service venue for all PEEC guests and visitors and is a 'natural' choice for special events in the Poconos.

# Less Time Traveling

## ACCOMMODATIONS:

**Cabins** - PEEC's overnight guests are housed in cabins, which can comfortably sleep 2-16 persons on bunk beds with camp-style mattresses.

**New Duplex Cabins** - Four duplex cabins sleep up to 6 guests per side.

### New Guest Lodges -

- Two new lodges comfortably accommodate 40 guests (20 per wing)
- Each wing has 10 bunk beds, a semi-private chaperone room and large ADA bathroom & showers.

**Yurt Village & Bathhouse** - The Yurt is a cross between a Buckminster Fuller geodesic dome and a luxury safari tent. PEEC has Yurts that accommodate 6-8 guests each with bunk beds, heat and electricity. A new bathhouse is also located in the Yurt Village.

**Group Tenting Area** - Five tenting platforms with tents that comfortably sleep 6/tent.
