Badge information and requirements can be found on the BSA website. Pre-requisites should be completed either individually or as a troop, usually before coming to PEEC. Please bring photos or reports and be prepared to discuss with your merit badge counselor. This list is subject to staff availability.

Group	Badge/Program	Pre-requisites
All groups	Boy Scout Ranger	Willingness to work outdoors to complete service projects
Tiger Scouts	Backyard Jungle	None
Tiger Scouts	Games Tigers Play	4, 5 (bring snack to share)
Tiger Scouts	Tigers in the Wild	Bring handbook, 5 (PEEC can provide a campfire for troops staying overnight but you will need to run your own meeting)
Wolf Scouts	Call of the wild	1, 6 (PEEC can provide a campfire for troops who stay overnight but you will need to run your own program)
Wolf Scouts	Paws on the Path	None
Wolf Scouts	Digging in the Past	Let PEEC know if you have any food allergies
Wolf Scouts	Finding Your Way	Bring a map of your town (acceptable to zoom in and print from Google maps)
Bear Scouts	Fur, Feathers, Ferns	None
Bear Scouts	Bear Necessities	5, 6, 9
Webelos	Webelos Walkabout	2- bring a first aid kit to share, 4 - Make and bring a bagged lunch to eat on trail
Webelos	Castaway	2b
Webelos	Earth Rocks!	6, bring Webelos handbook
Webelos	Into the Wild	Choose and complete one from 1-4 (PEEC will cover 5-9)
Webelos	Into the Woods	None
Boy Scouts	Backpacking	8, 9b-d (bring pack with equipment), 10, 11b-c
Boy Scouts	Bird Study	7 (bring report/evidence and be ready to discuss), 8 (bring picture and be prepared to discuss)
Boy Scouts	Camping	4 (if troop is staying in tent site, do on own), 8d, 9
Boy Scouts	Environmental Science	Bring camera (phone camera is fine), 3e, 3f
Boy Scouts	Fish and Wildlife Management	5,6,7 (bring pictures/reports and be prepared to discuss)
Boy Scouts	Geology	PEEC needs two months advance notice for this badge due to scheduling off-site quarry trip. Pre-req 5d4 (bring with to show)
Boy Scouts	Hiking	5,6,7, bring report
Boy Scouts	Mammal Study	3
Boy Scouts	Nature Study	4a, 4.d. (collect outside the park)
Boy Scouts	Soil and Water Conservation	7
Boy Scouts	Wilderness Survival	5, 8 (PEEC can teach shelter building but scouts will need to stay on own in shelter with troop leader)
